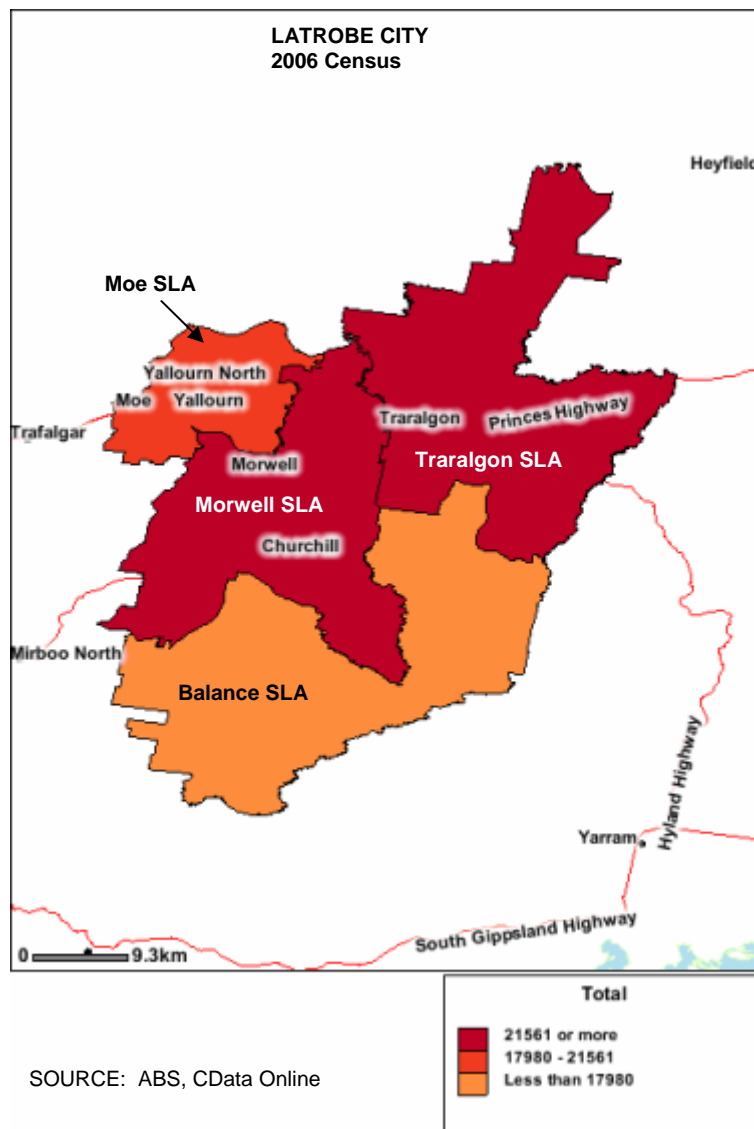

The map below shows total population by Statistical Local Area for Latrobe City compiled from ABS CData Online. At 2006 Census total persons for Latrobe City was 69 328.

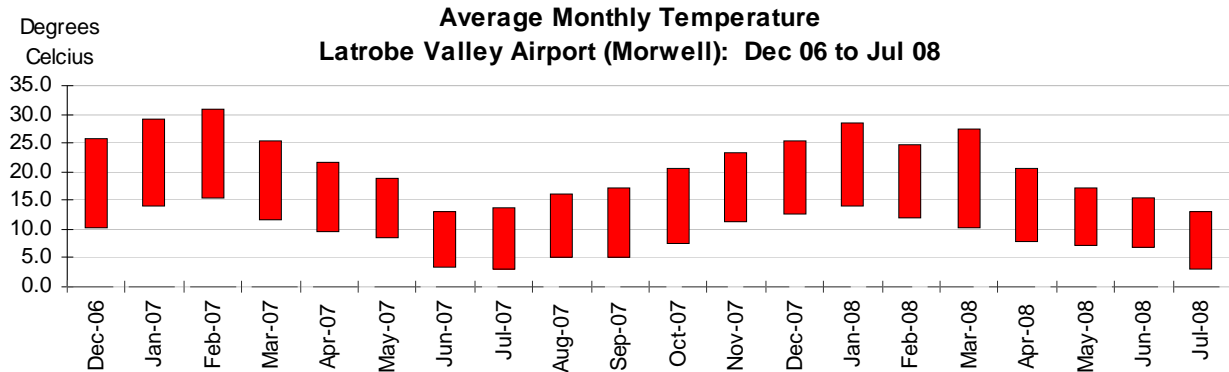

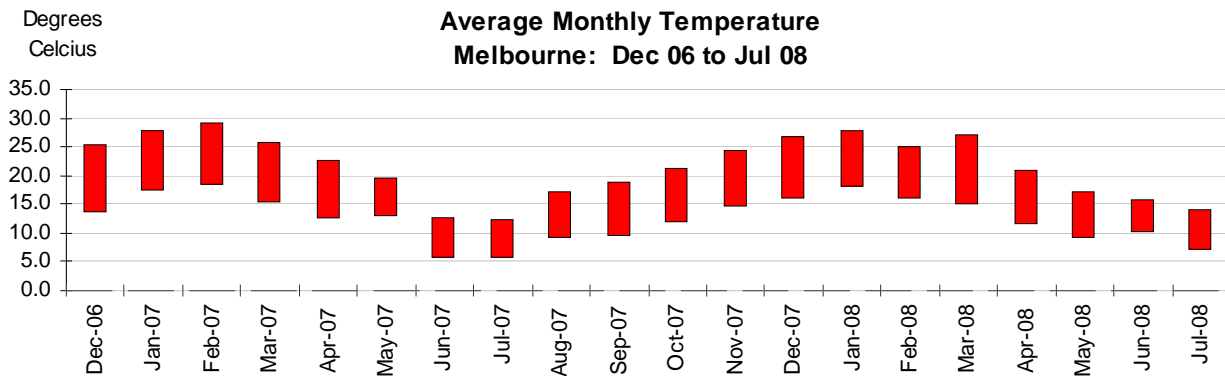

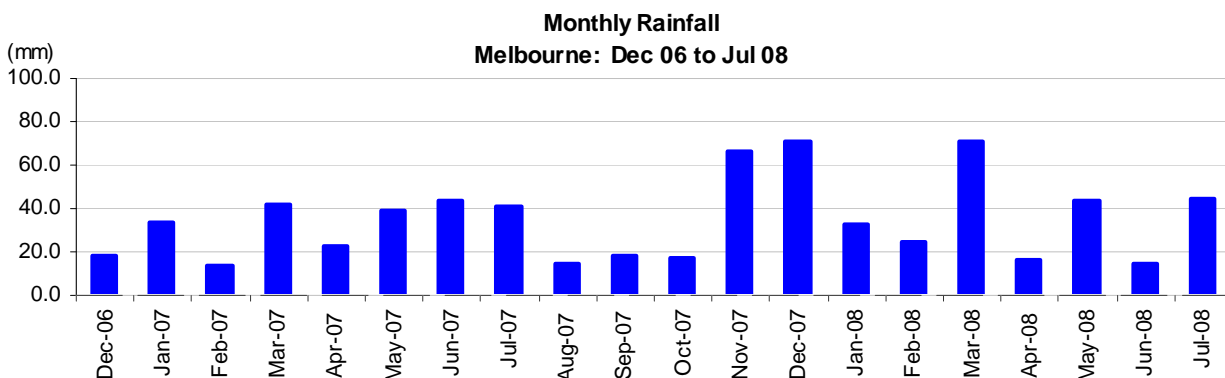

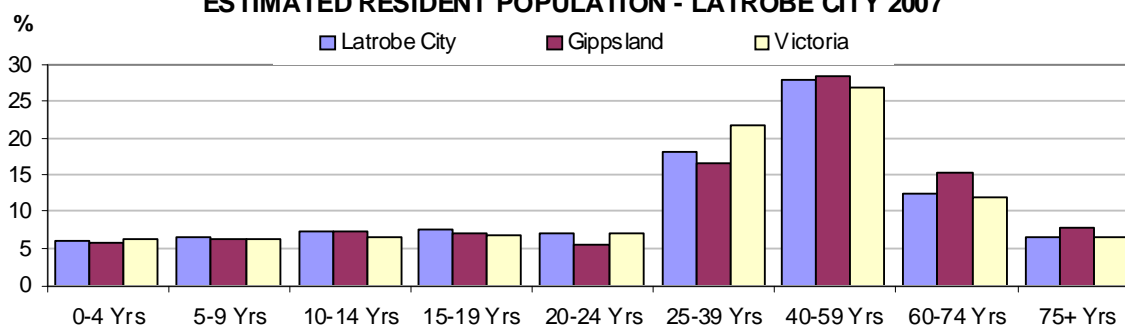

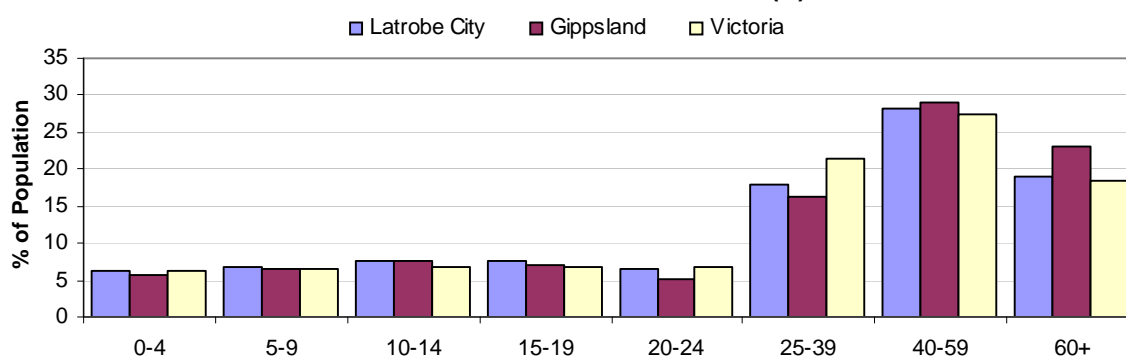

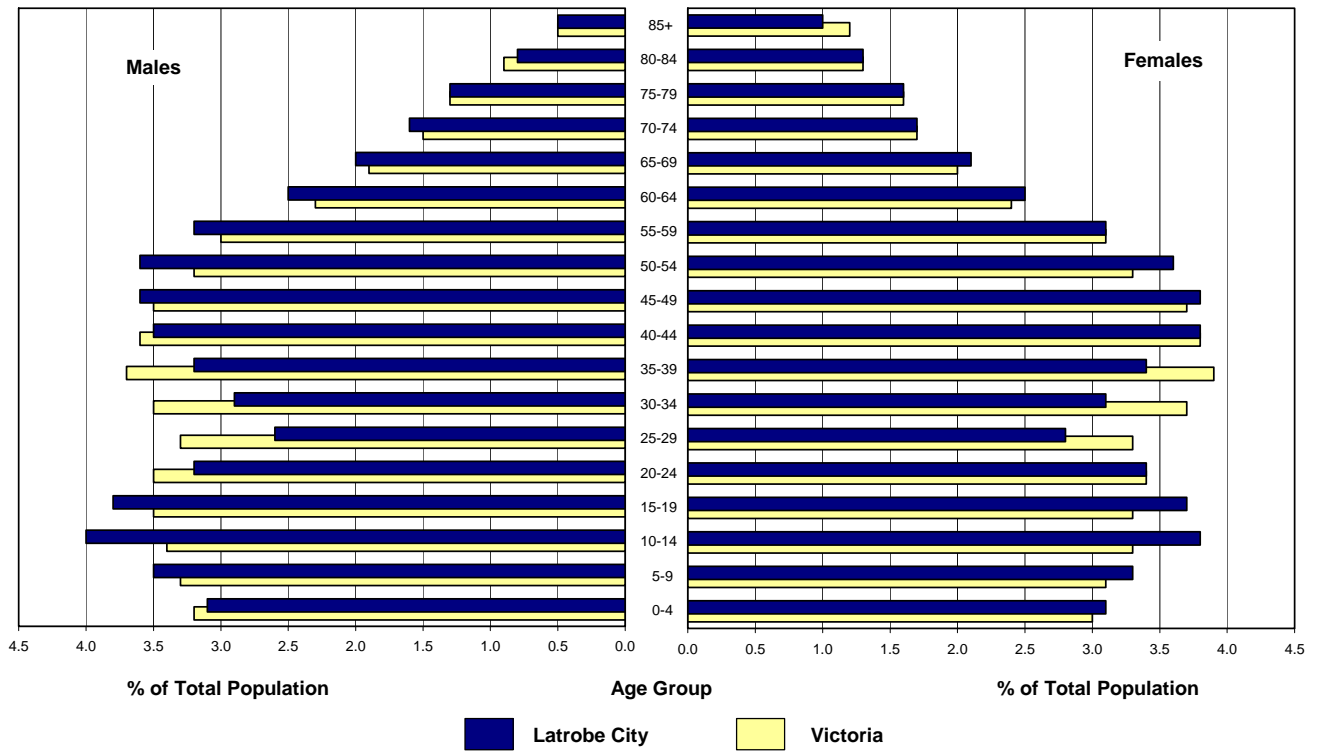

AGE DISTRIBUTION 2006 CENSUS (%)



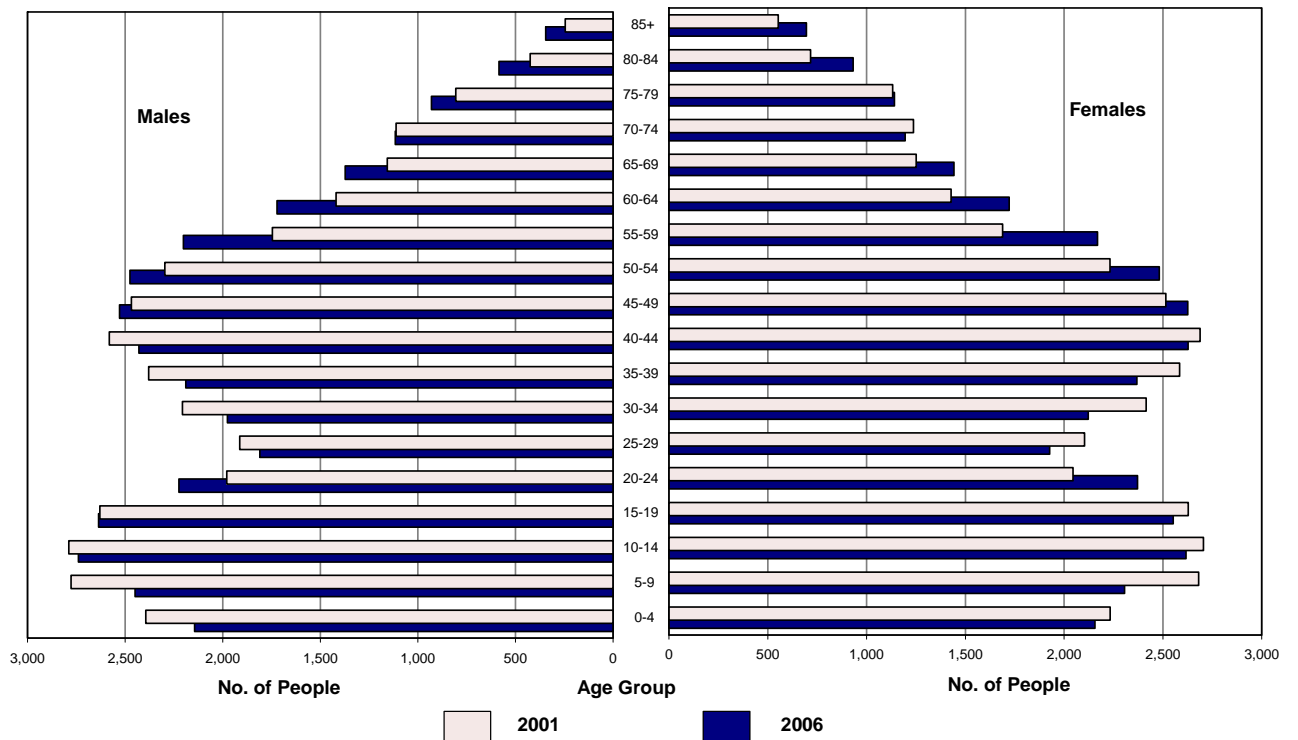

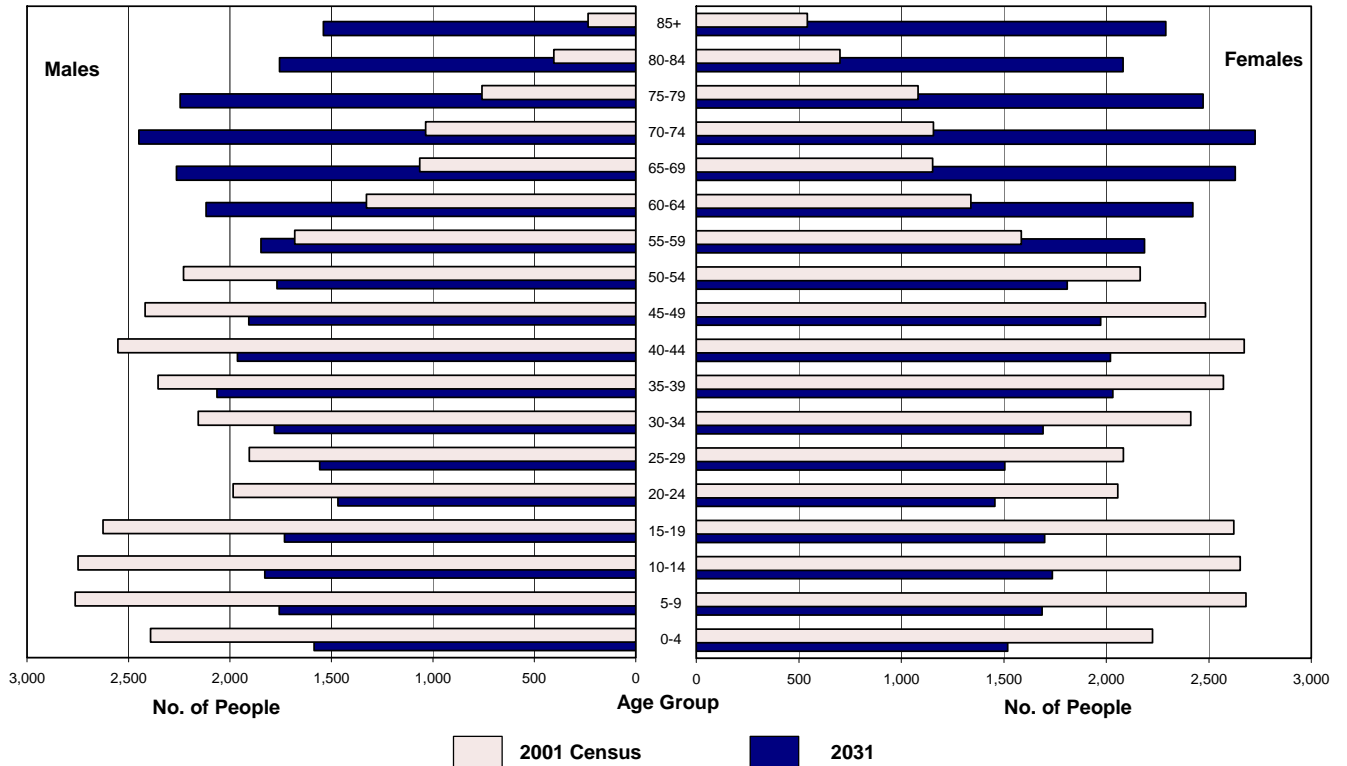

Population Projections, Latrobe City, 2001 Census & 2031

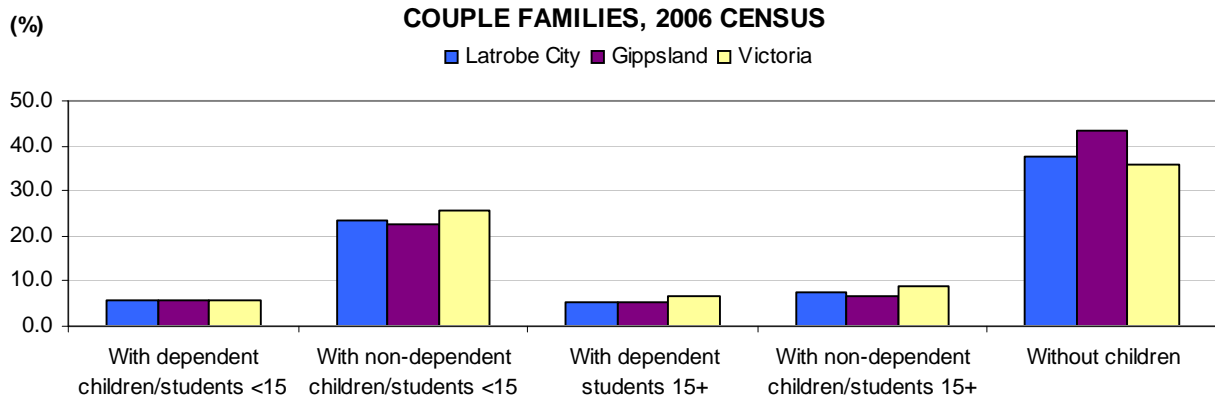

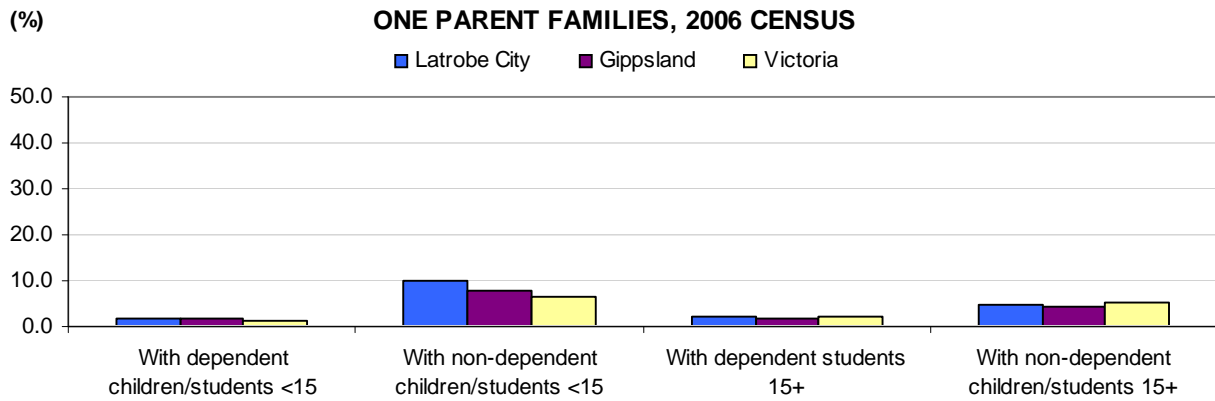

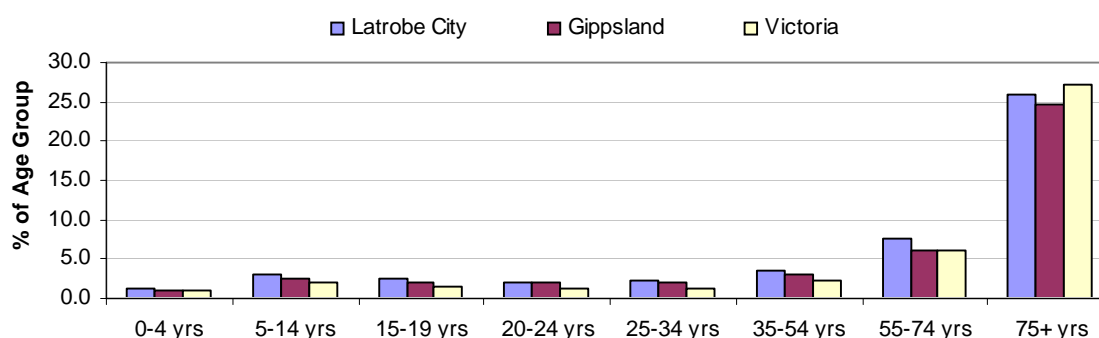

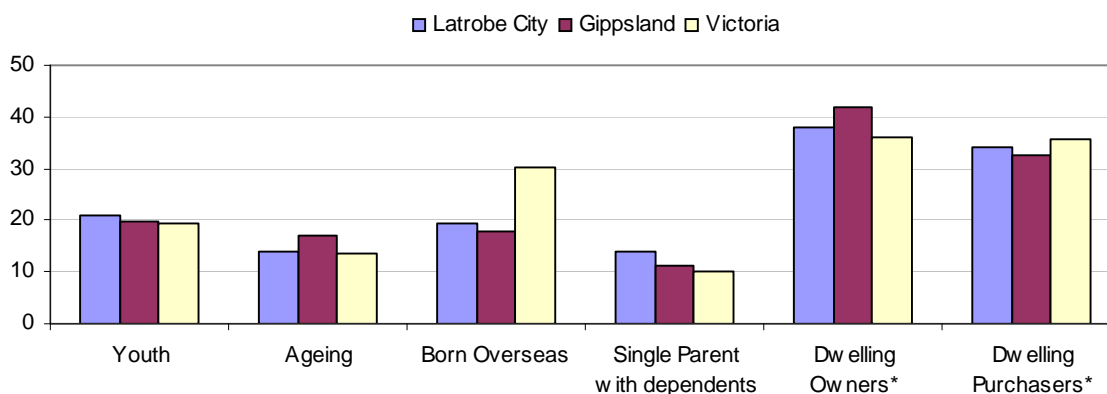

SELECTED POPULATION CHARACTERISTICS: 2006 CENSUS



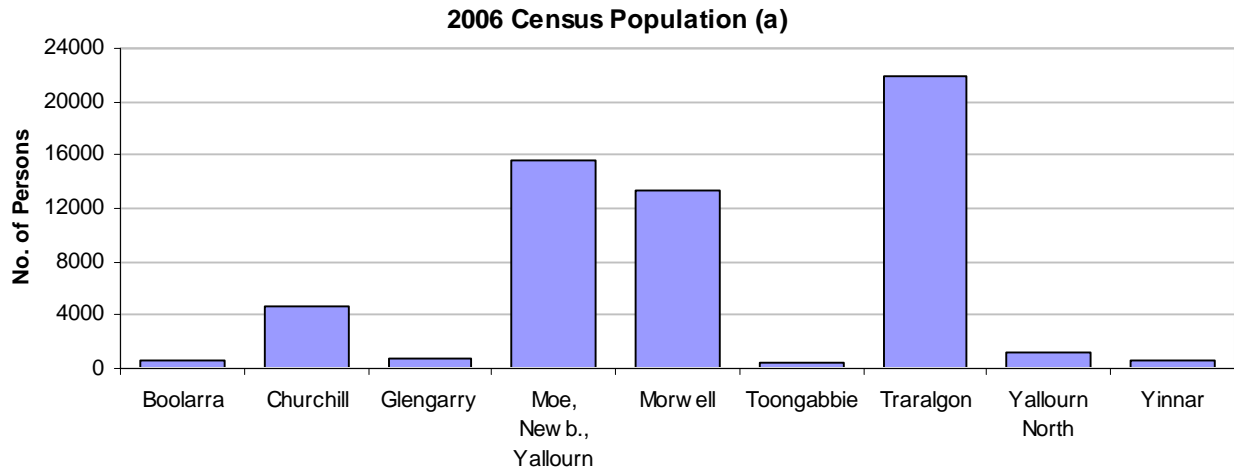

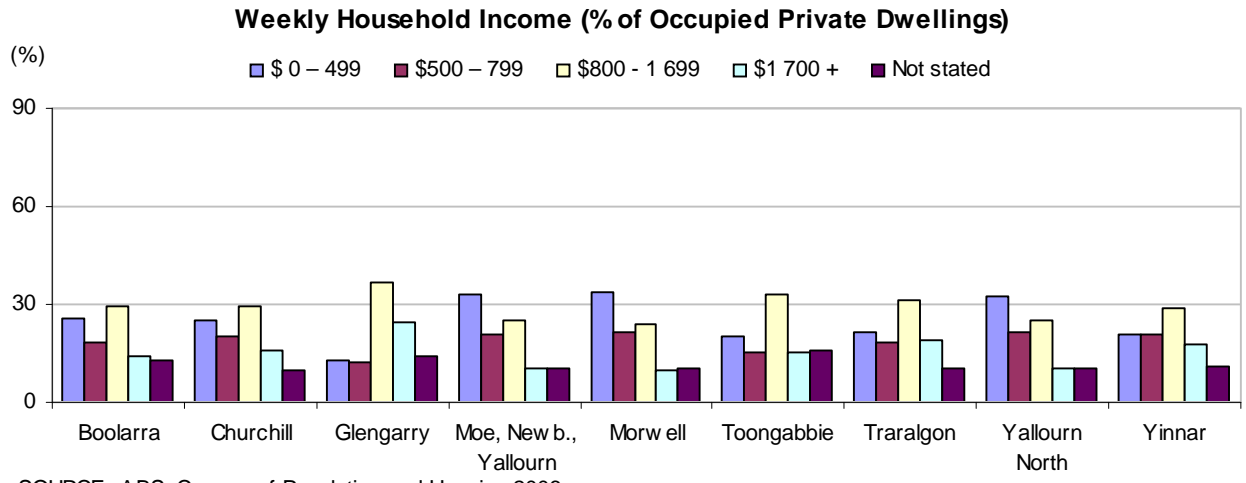

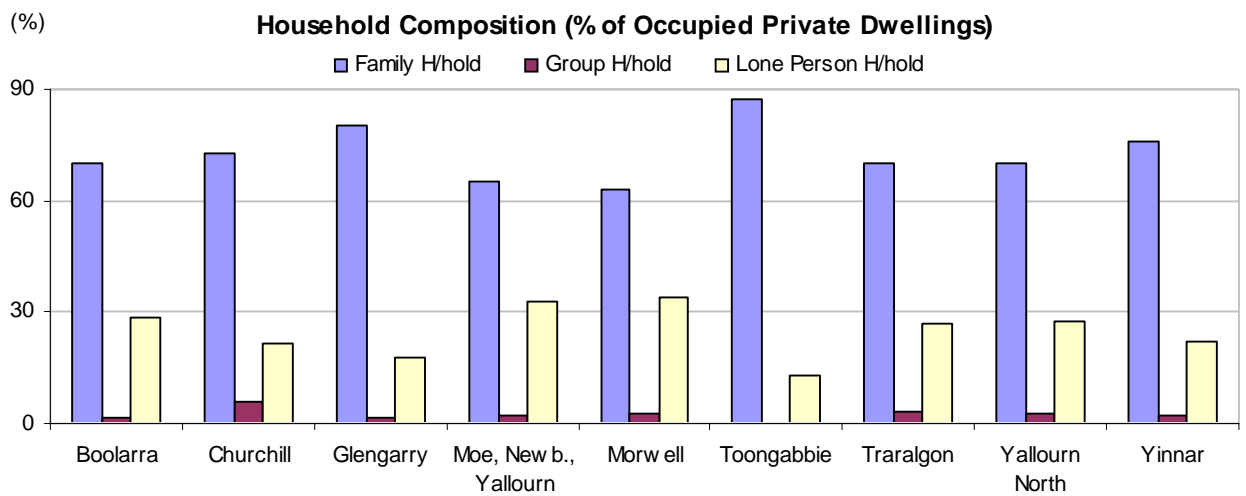

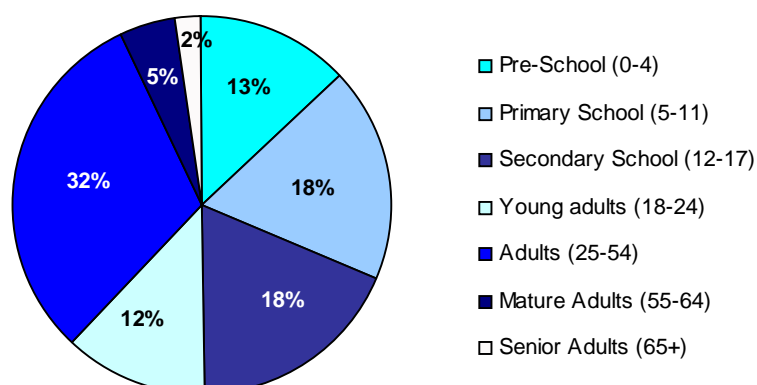

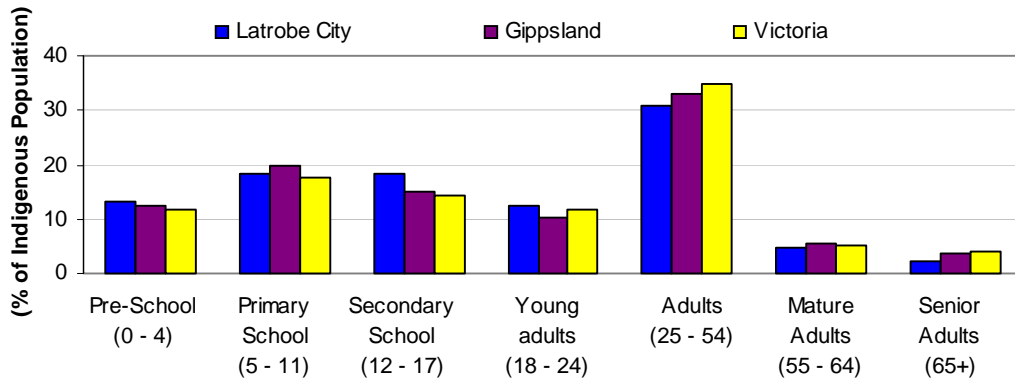

INDIGENOUS POPULATION AGE STRUCTURE Latrobe City: 2006 Census



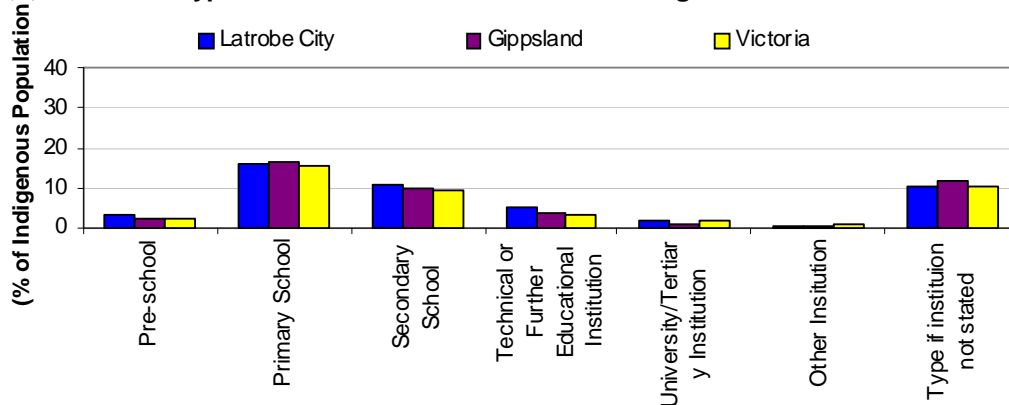

AGE STRUCTURE: 2006 Census**



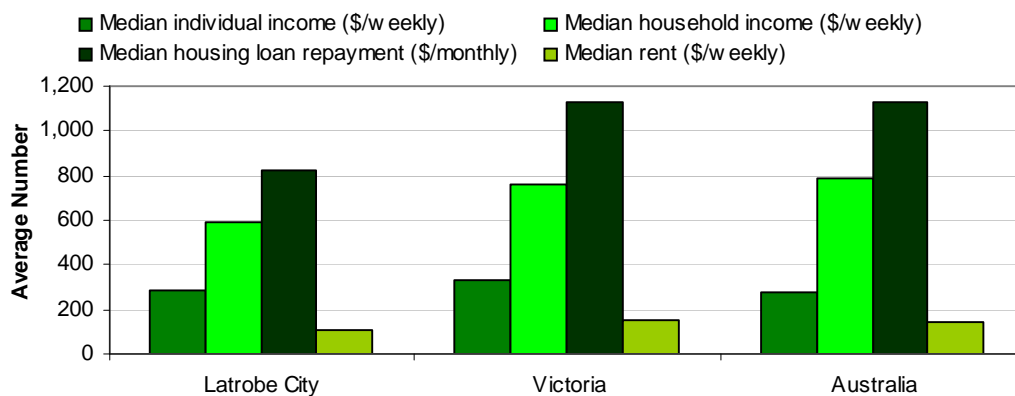

SELECTED AVERAGES: 2006 Census**



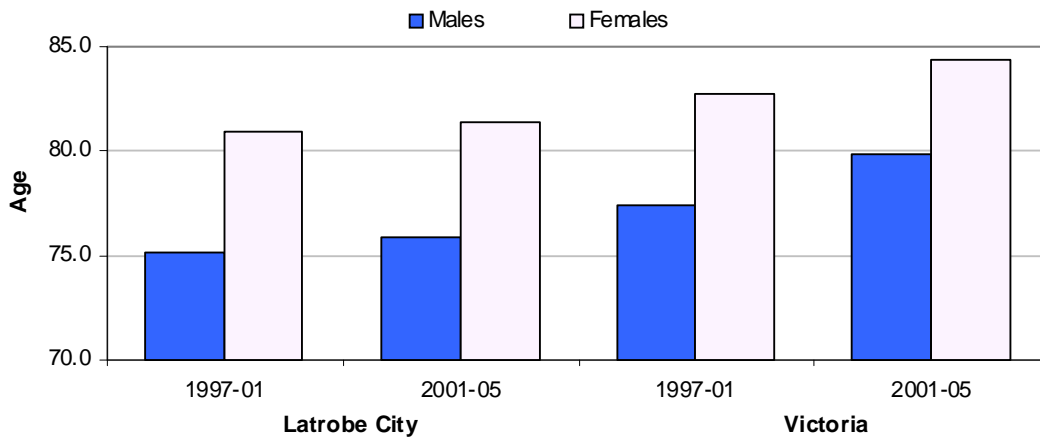

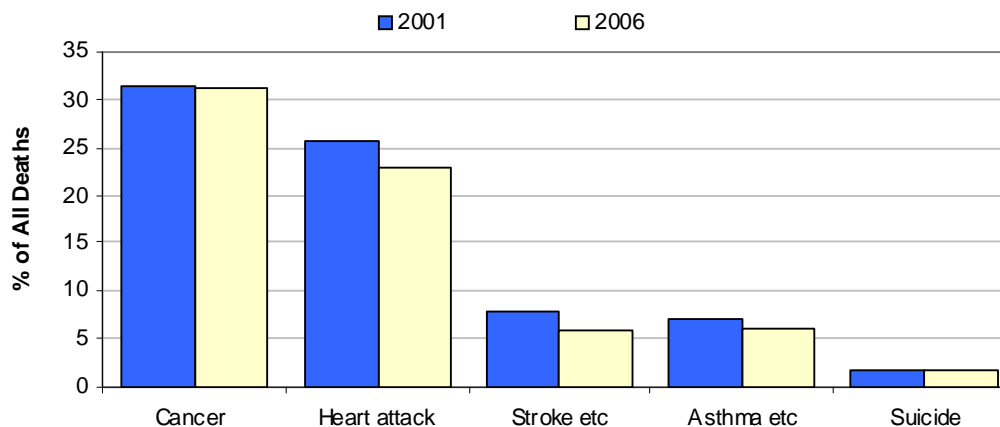

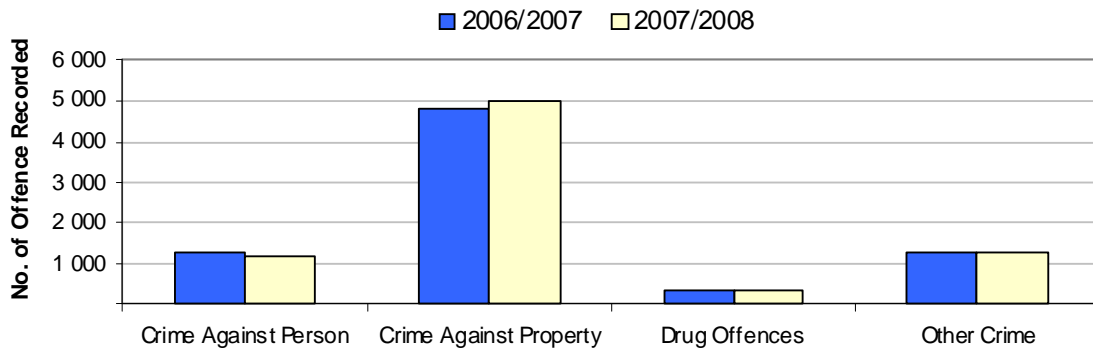

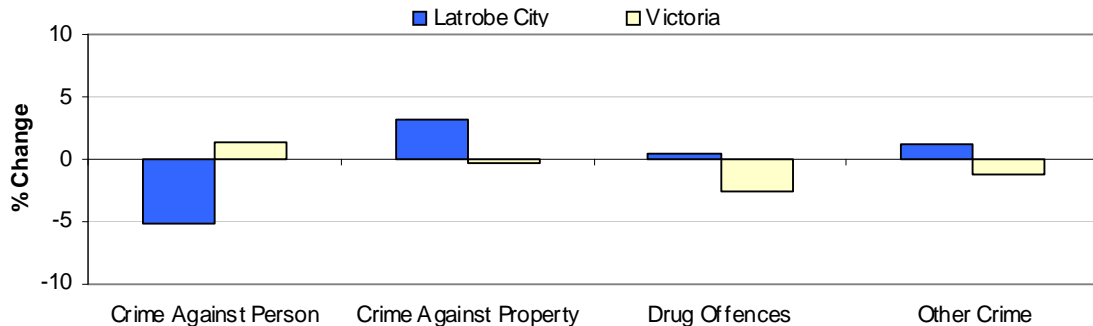

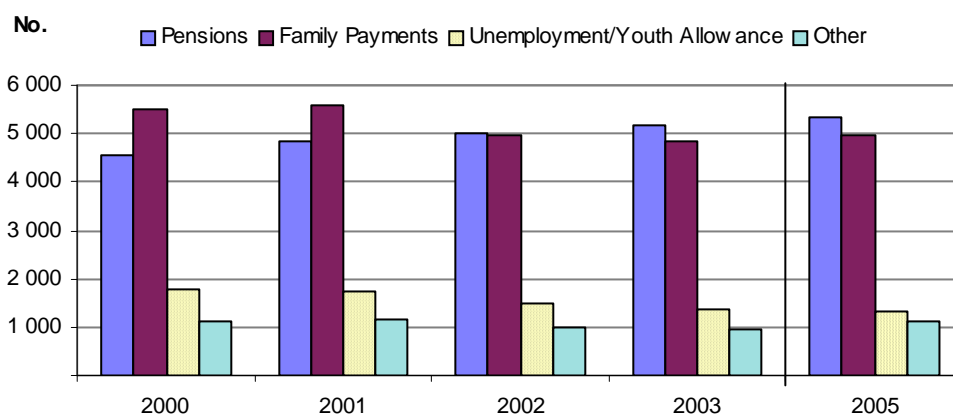

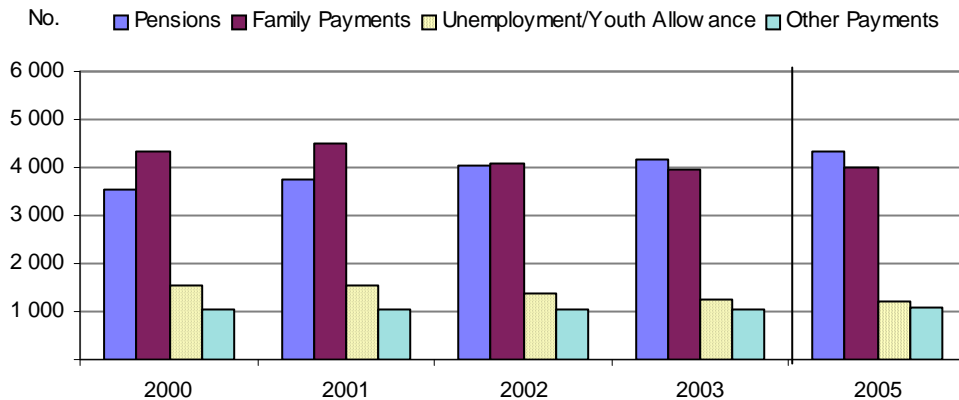

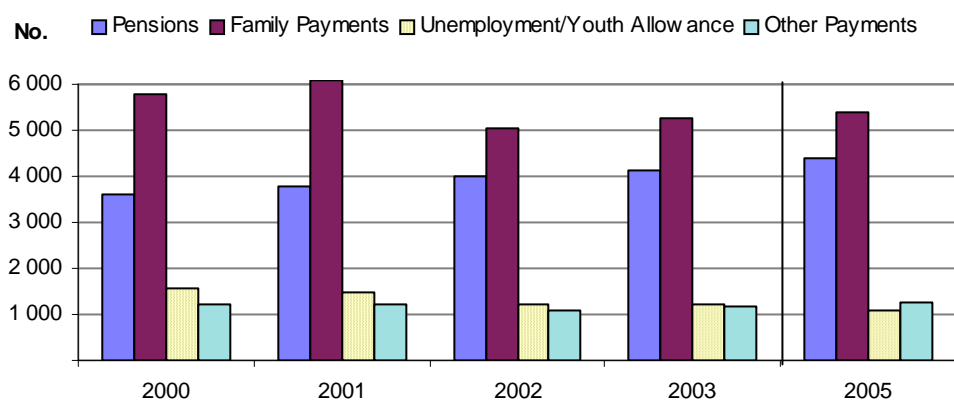

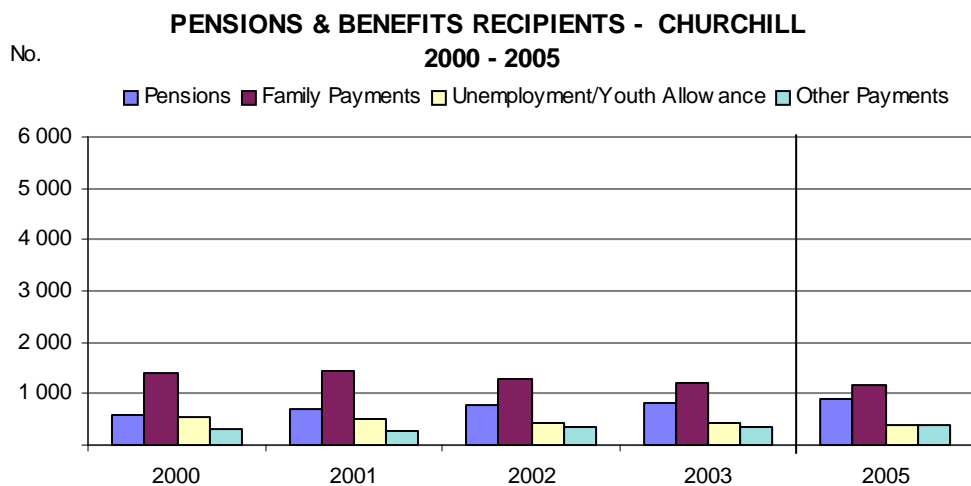

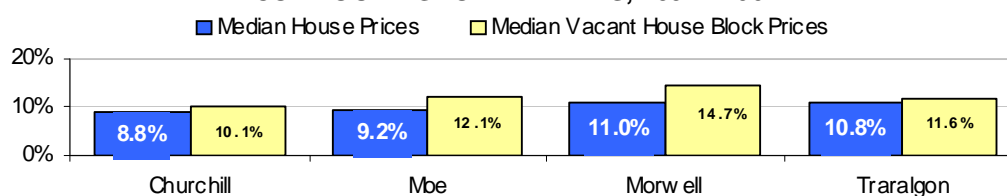

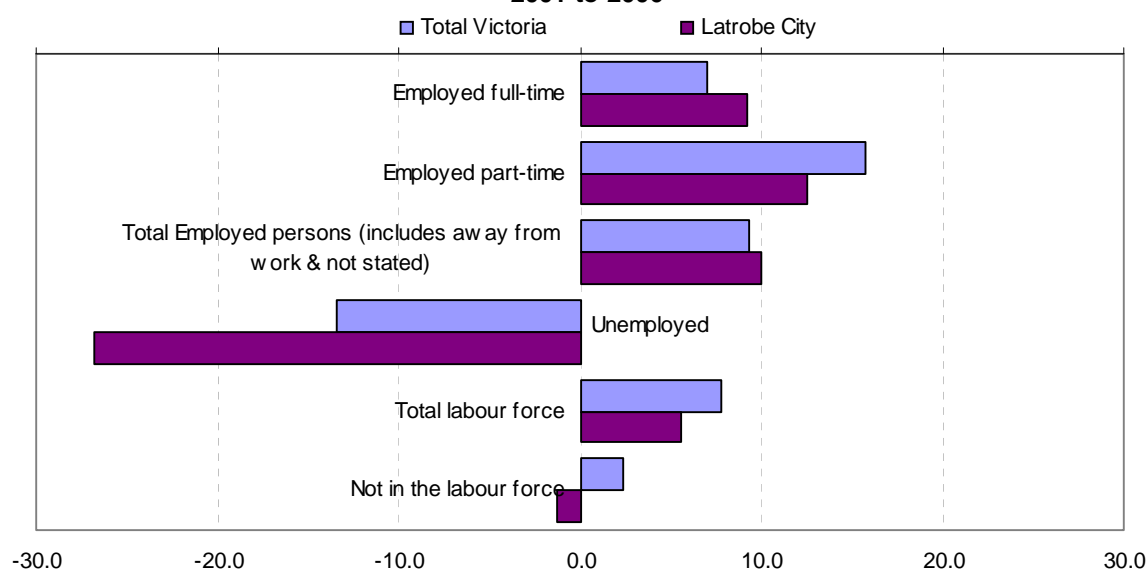

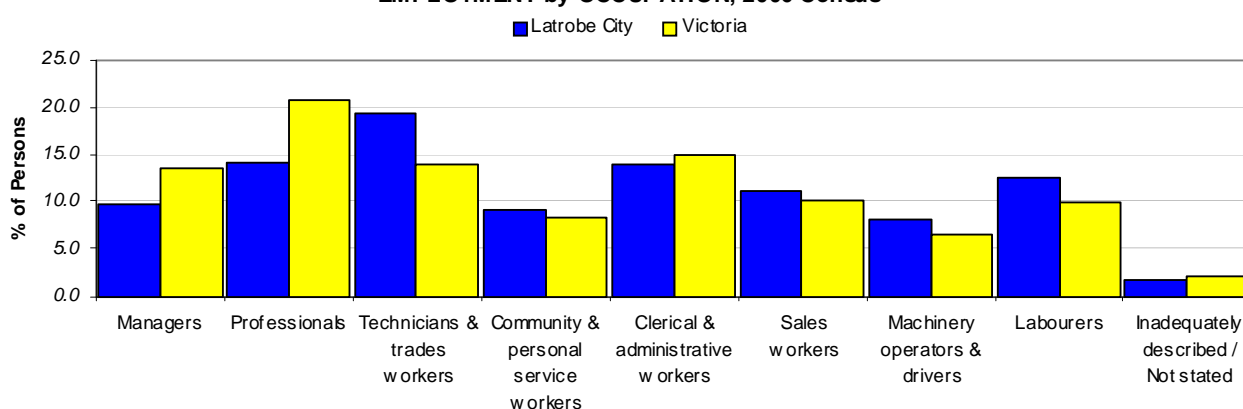
**% Change in Labour Force: Latrobe City & Victoria

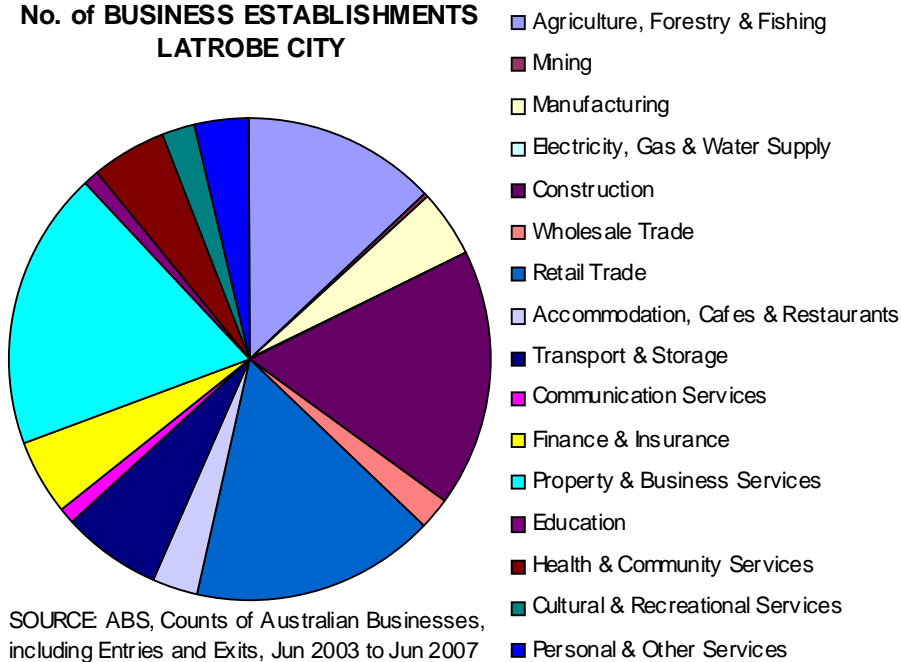

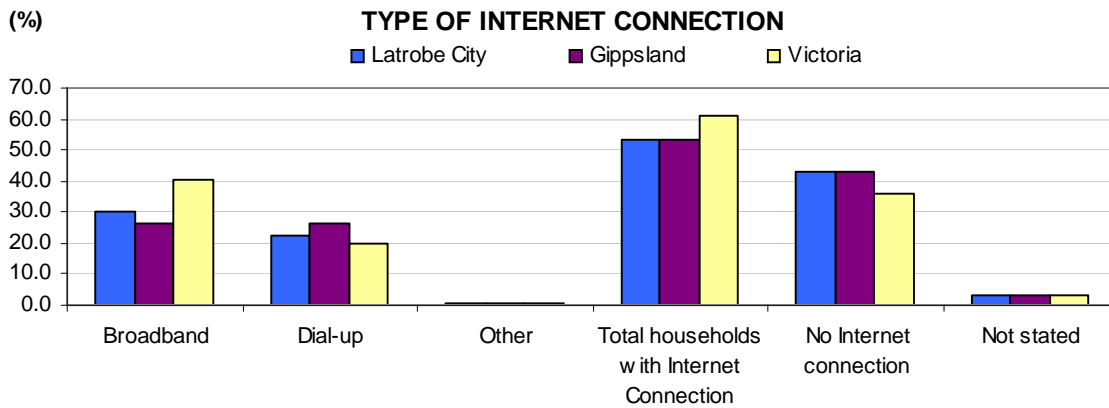

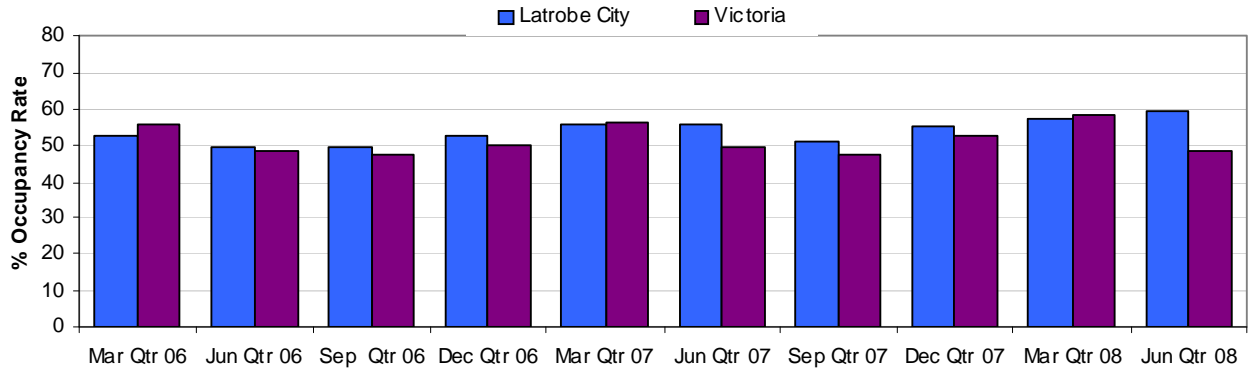
