If within one month after the service of this notice you do not agree with me as to the construction and kind of fence, I will apply pursuant to the Fences Act 1958 to a Court of Petty Sessions for an order describing the type of fence to be constructed, what portion thereof shall be contributed by each adjoining occupier and such further order as may be necessary.
