## Forts and Cities



Forts are fun. You can use them as a cubby house inside or outside and have some great adventures. You can build a whole city!

You'll need:

- Some cardboard boxes
- Paints, textas, scissors, tape, glue
- Or some tables and chairs and old sheets and blankets

### Method

Place your boxes to make a fort and tower. Use smaller boxes to make a fence around it. Paint bricks and cut windows and a door.

Or use the sides of boxes to make a city. Draw or paint bricks and doors on the buildings.

What animals would soldiers in your fort have? You can make a horse out of a broom or you may have a rocking horse, or you can use your imagination. An old pram makes a good cart for your horse!

If you don't have any boxes, you can also make a fort by covering a table with a cloth or old sheet. You can draw walls on the old sheet.

Use your teddy bears or dolls for fellow soldiers or visitors to your city.
