#### CHILDREN'S WEEK 2020 DRAWING COMPETITION

# **Terms and Conditions**

- 1. The 2020 Latrobe City Children's Week Drawing Competition is open to entries from October 22, 2020 to November 3, 2020.
- 2. All entries must be submitted via the online form at <a href="www.latrobe.vic.gov.au/childrensweek">www.latrobe.vic.gov.au/childrensweek</a> by November 3 2020, 11pm.
- 3. This competition is open to children 12 years old and under who have been entered by a parent, legal guardian, teacher or educational program manager. It is not the responsibility of the Latrobe City Council to obtain parental consent where the child's artwork is registered by a program manager or teacher. If a teacher or program manager is entering a child's work, it will be assumed that any necessary parental consent has first been obtained by them.
- 4. First and runner-up prizes will be awarded to the categories under 5 years, 5-8 years and 9-12 years. Prizes will be awarded for the most creative entry. Additional prizes and commendations may be given.
- 5. A second chance draw will be performed with the remaining non-winning entries of each category. All remaining non-winning entries of each category will have an equal chance of winning prizes from a second chance draw. A minimum of four prizes will be drawn and awarded for each entrant category.

- 7. Latrobe City Council reserves the right to substitute any prize of equal value at their discretion and does not accept responsibility for businesses reopening in order for prizes to be redeemed. Prizes can only be redeemed during operation day and hours of the applicable businesses.
- 8. Entries are based on the child's age at the time an entry is received. Latrobe City Council reserves the right to require an entrant to submit a copy of proof of age.
- 9. One entry may be submitted per child.
- 10. Submitted artwork must be the child's original creation. Making an exact copy of any pre-existing image is not acceptable, whether visually or by tracing. Colouring in an outline printed or drawn by someone else or having someone else contribute to the artwork is also not acceptable. Artwork must not be overly derivative of images found on the Internet, in print media, or elsewhere. Judges will disqualify a work if they reasonably suspect that it is wholly copied from other works. Adults may give encouragement but must not have a hands-on role in creating the artwork.
- 11. All entries must be a drawn or painted. Photographs, videos, mixed-media and three-dimensional sculptures will not be accepted.
- 12. Artworks must be drawn or painted on the official entry template published in the Latrobe Valley Express on Thursday 22 October or downloaded from <a href="https://www.latrobe.vic.gov.au.childrensweek">www.latrobe.vic.gov.au.childrensweek</a>
- 13. A clear digital copy of artwork of no more than 10MB from scans or photographs must be sent via the online form at <a href="https://www.latrobe.vic.gov.au/childrensweek">www.latrobe.vic.gov.au/childrensweek</a>
- 14. All adults entering a child or children must submit their own name, email address, phone number, and relationship to the child, and the child's name, age, and town, along with the artwork, and agree to the terms and conditions of the competition.
- 15. Each entry will be individually judged, based upon the child's individual creative expression celebrating their friendships.
- 16. The judge's decisions are final and without appeal in all matters related to this competition and the awarding of the prizes.
- 17. The judge or judges of this competition will be and/or delegated by Latrobe City Council's Director of Arts.
- 18. Latrobe City Council reserves the right to disqualify any entrant submitting an entry which, in the opinion of the judges, includes objectionable content, including but not limited to profanity, nudity, potentially insulting, scandalous, inflammatory or defamatory images or language.
- 19. Entries will be judged and drawn on Wednesday 4 November 2020 and the winner's will be published on Council's website within 30 days of the draw.
- 20. Prize winners will be notified in writing by email within ten working days of the conclusion of the competition.



- 21. If Latrobe City Council is unable to contact the winner within ten days of the draw and has made every effort to contact them with the information provided by the entrant then the prize will be awarded to another valid entrant.
- 22. Prize winners will be contacted via those who have entered them by email.
- 23. Prize winners will be announced and contacted by Monday 9 November, and winners may also be acknowledged on the website and through social media.
- 24. Prizes are not redeemable for cash. Prize cannot be exchanged. In the event that, for any reason, a winner cannot be contacted and/or does not accept the prize, the prize will be forfeited by the winner.
- 25. By entering the competition, all entrants will be deemed to have accepted and agreed to be bound by these terms and conditions with the consent of their guardian and consent to the publishing or displaying their artwork online, social media or physically.
- 26. Latrobe City Council assumes no responsibility for lost, stolen, delayed, damaged, illegible, incomplete or misdirected entries, or for any problems or technical malfunction of any telephone network or lines, computer on-line systems, servers, access providers, computer equipment, software, failure of any entry to be received or traffic congestion on the internet or at any website, or any combination thereof including any injury or damage to an entrant's or any other person's computer related to or resulting from playing or downloading any material in the contest.
- 27. Latrobe City Council shall not be liable for any loss or damage whatsoever which is suffered (including, but not limited to, indirect or consequential loss) or for personal injury which is suffered or sustained, in connection with the prize, or competition except for any liability which cannot be excluded by laws.
- 28. Latrobe City Council reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to modify, cancel or suspend this competition or any part of it should an external circumstance arise which are beyond the reasonable control of Latrobe City Council.
- 29. Latrobe City Council is not responsible for any errors or omissions in printing or advertising this competition. This competition will run in accordance with these terms and conditions, subject to amendment by Latrobe City Council.
- 30. Latrobe City Council employees and their immediate families are ineligible to enter the competition.
- 31. Only one entry is permitted per person.
- 32. The Latrobe City Council reserves the right to verify the validity of entries.
- 33. Latrobe City Council will not share any personal information about entrants with any other party, without the consent of the parent, teacher, program manager or guardian. Latrobe City Council collects personal information of entrants and their guardian for the purposes of registration and to notify winners.
