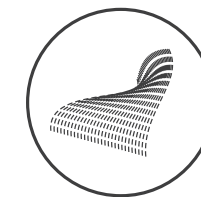


# Latrobe City Council Disability Access & Inclusion Plan 2022-25 Year 1 Actions
