## PROJECT UPDATE: MOE REVITALISATION PROJECT

The Moe Revitalisation Project is now underway. The project will see the construction of a youth space including a skate park for all skill levels, a play space, barbeque and picnic area, green spaces and associated amenities.

Latrobe City Council is delivering this project in partnership with the Victorian Government. The project will be built on George Street in Moe. Alternative parking on George Street can be found at the site of the old skate park, opposite Woolworths.

Typical project working hours will be between 7am to 6pm Monday to Friday (except in special circumstances). Works are expected to be completed by mid-2023. Every effort will be made to minimise the impacts to the community during the construction works.

From Monday 5 December, fencing will be erected around the site with preliminary work including clearing of the area. When possible, some fencing will be removed to allow for car parking when works are not being conducted.

The new 100 space car park opposite TM&H Mitre 10 is estimated to be completed in mid- December.
