Work recently completed

Latrobe City Council is pleased to see remediation works complete at 63 of the registered sites it is monitoring.

Roads where work has been completed since the previous Newsletter include Hallams Road, Jeeralang North Road, Jeeralang West Road, Jumbuk Road, Lindners Road, Morwell River East Branch Road, Prosper Valley Road, Shellcotts Road.

Roadwork is still in progress at other sites on several of these roads.

Schedule for completion

All work associated with the June 2021 storms and floods remains scheduled for completion during the 2022-2023 financial year. Work to repair damage at several sites due to the 2022 storms will take longer to complete.

Work is scheduled to take place on Jeeralang West Road, Jumbuk Road, Morwell River Road, and Traralgon Creek Road.

Road closures

To facilitate works at major disaster recovery sites the following roads are required to be closed during the period indicated:

- Around 900 Jeeralang West Road (From 11 April to June)
- Around 1125 Jumbuk Road (from 1 May for two weeks)
