What is the Latrobe Aerospace Technology Precinct?

The Latrobe Aerospace Technology Precinct (Precinct) will support an integrated Advanced Air Mobility (AAM) ecosystem combining flexible co-working facilities, offices, and infrastructure to accommodate various research and development, testing and manufacturing activities.

The ecosystem includes:

- A 'Launchpad' for start-up and developing AAM businesses
- Test and Evaluation range services
- Research and Development facilities
- Office spaces, meeting rooms, presentation areas
- Appropriately zoned areas for large-scale manufacturing and commercial production, including airside access
- Support services by Latrobe City Council and Victorian Government agencies
- Access to local supply of advanced manufacturing/engineering workforce and talent
- Various sizes of hangars available
- Security provisions at the controlled aerodrome including access control, key register, roving security during the day and CCTV coverage.

The Precinct infrastructure includes:

- Spaces that can be hired on a short, medium or long term basis under a defined membership model, including office/administration areas, hangar and outside areas, access to a butterfly net and airside access
- High speed broadband availability (FTTP)
- 3 phase power supply
- Security fencing.

FACILITIES FOR LEASE

Development Hangar

- Three 6m x 6m individually lockable office spaces
- One 5.8m x 4m office with direct airside access
- Mezzanine of 12m x 7.8m above offices
- Development floor space approx. 1,120m² (can be let in smaller areas for individual projects)
- 5 tonne overhead crane
- Development Hangar has airside access

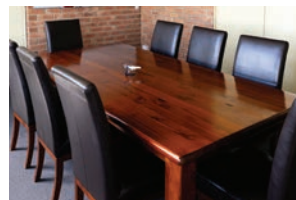
OFFICE AND MEETING FACILITIES

Offices

- Secure offices with internet access and car park
- Development Hangar - Three 6m x 6m individually lockable office spaces
- Development Hangar - One 5.8m x 4m office with direct airside access
- Commercial building - 10 offices (various sizes and configuration)
- Amenities include showers and kitchenette

Meeting Rooms

- Boardroom (Terminal)
- Terminal building (for presentations, events, conferences)
- Meeting room (Development Hangar)
- All meeting facilities include access to kitchen areas for food preparation, tea/coffee and storage
