- The facilities contained in the areas of the precinct include the Loy Yang Power Latrobe Community Soundshell, extensive walking paths, Traralgon Creek viewing platforms, playgrounds, carparks, barbeque shelters, rotunda, extensive open space areas, seating and community tennis courts, Monomeath Senior Citizens Centre, Gippsland Model Engineering Society, Small Bore Rifle Club and 1st Traralgon Scout Group.

About the Positions

Latrobe City Council is seeking Expressions of Interest to fill two community representative positions.

- All members are appointed for a term of three years.
- Have a strong interest in advising Latrobe City in the management, development, use and maintenance of the Victory Park Precinct areas.
- Interested persons are to be over the age of eighteen years, be a resident of Latrobe City or own property and/or work in the municipality.
- The Advisory Committee currently meets bi-monthly at Gippsland Regional Indoor Sports Stadium Traralgon. The duration of each meeting will generally not exceed two hours. Special meetings may be held on an 'as required' basis.
- Appointments to the Advisory Committee are made by Latrobe City Council.
- All positions are on a voluntary basis and Latrobe City does not offer any remuneration for participation.
- All positions can refer to Latrobe City's Coordinator Recreation Liaison for assistance and advice throughout their term of appointment.

About the Victory Park Precinct Advisory Committee

- The Committee's role is to advise Latrobe City Council City on the management, development, use and maintenance of the Victory Park Precinct areas under a Terms of Reference operating document.
- The Advisory Committee and its members are covered by Latrobe City's Public Liability insurance and Personal Accident cover whilst undertaking duties in the discharge of its responsibilities as per the Terms of Reference operating document.
- The Committee does not have any delegated decision making authorities.


