LEGENDS

Elite competitors who have achieved sporting excellence by competing at the highest level.

MEMBERS

Athletes, coaches, officials, administrators, managers, mentors, sports scientists and sports media who have made a significant contribution to sport.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- The name of at least one referee must be supplied; this person may be contacted if the nominee is shortlisted.
- All nomination information and material submitted remains the property of Latrobe City Council.
- The decision of the Latrobe City Council in relation to the awards is final and no correspondence will be entered into in respect of the decision.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

CATEGORIES

- A person may be nominated for inclusion in the Latrobe City Sporting Hall of Fame under two categories, as follows:
 - **Legend** – Status available only to competitors.
 - **Member** – Status available to all other sports people, including administrators, coaches, sports scientists, sports medicine and sports media.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- A person nominated for inclusion in the Latrobe City Sporting Hall of Fame shall meet at least one of the following criteria:
 - Have been nurtured in the sport in Latrobe City for at least five years as a child, youth or young adult (e.g. as a student, but the basis for nomination was established while residing and competing outside Latrobe City), or;
 - Have resided outside Latrobe City, but who has competed in a Latrobe City sporting association for at least five years, during which time the basis for nomination was established.
- The principal criteria for all selections is demonstrated achievement at an elite level in the sport(s) in which they have participated or served. Achievements in sport without the element of competition should be exceptional to be considered.
- Regular participation in a high level competition without success is not highly regarded.
- In respect to **Members**, achievement arising from personal effort or initiative is essential. Long-term service is not sufficient in itself.
- A person, who in judgment of the Latrobe City Sporting Hall of Fame Induction Committee, has committed conduct prejudicial to the Hall and its good name, shall be ineligible for induction or shall be removed from the Hall, whichever may be the case.

- In considering persons, such as those from an earlier era, who had limited opportunity to compete at an elite level, the Latrobe City Sporting Hall of Fame Induction Committee shall give due weight to the experts' opinions of that person's sporting peers (e.g. fellow competitors from the same earlier era), providing those opinions have been recorded (i.e. letters, tapes, video, newspapers etc.) and authenticated.
- Any nominated individual shall have retired or ceased competition at the highest possible level for a period no less than five years before becoming eligible to be inducted into the Sporting Hall of Fame as a **Legend**.

Nominations must be on the official form (one nomination per form).

All nominations must be received by Friday 11 September 2026, 5pm.
