

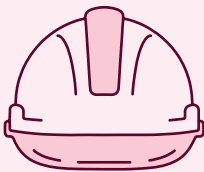
Your rates at work

Where your rates go and how they support services, infrastructure and community facilities across Latrobe City

Latrobe City ratepayers will receive their annual property rates notices by post or email over the coming fortnight. Rates make up about 47 percent of Council's total revenue and help fund the services, facilities and infrastructure that support our community every day. Rates are calculated using your property's Capital Improved Value (total value of the land and any improvements made to it, such as buildings, structures or landscaping) and property classification, such as residential, commercial, farm or derelict land.

Latrobe City Council has: The lowest average rates in Gippsland.
The second-lowest waste service charge in Gippsland.
While keeping costs affordable, Council continues to deliver hundreds of services and maintain community assets across the municipality.

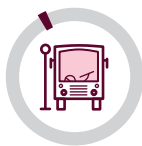
