Visitors can also use all-terrain wheelchairs to access the stunning beaches or the parks' spectacular trails. These are also available at the Grampians and Point Nepean National Parks.

ACCESSIBLE GIPPSLAND

All tourism experiences included in this brochure meet the following minimum access criteria:

- 1. Accessible parking** – designated accessible parking bay or sufficient space for a person with limited mobility including wheelchair users, to park and access their vehicle.
- 2. Clear accessible path of travel to entrance** – clear and accessible pathway to entrance avoiding hazards such as street furniture or building features.
- 3. Accessible entrance** – a level threshold (no steps) to the main entrance including easy to open door/s.
- 4. Adequate circulation space** – for a person with limited mobility including wheelchair users, to move around freely inside and outside.
- 5. Accessible toilet facilities** – designated accessible toilet facility for a person with limited mobility, including wheelchair users.
- 6. Accessible room (for accommodation)** – level threshold entry, adequate circulation space and designated accessible bathroom for a person with limited mobility, including wheelchair users.

Some experiences meet accessibility requirements above the minimum criteria. Visitors are encouraged to contact businesses directly if they have specific access requirements.

### Be safe around and on the water

Most water-related accidents can be avoided by knowing how to stay safe and following a few simple guidelines:

- Always swim between the red and yellow flags on the beach
- Always supervise children near water
- Never swim alone
- Know how to identify a rip current
- Pay attention to warnings and information signs
- Look before you leap and never turn your back on the sea
- Have lifejackets for all on board a boat
- Do not drink alcohol and either swim, surf, fish from the rocks or operate a boat.

**Distance:** North Point Loop Track 2.5km return

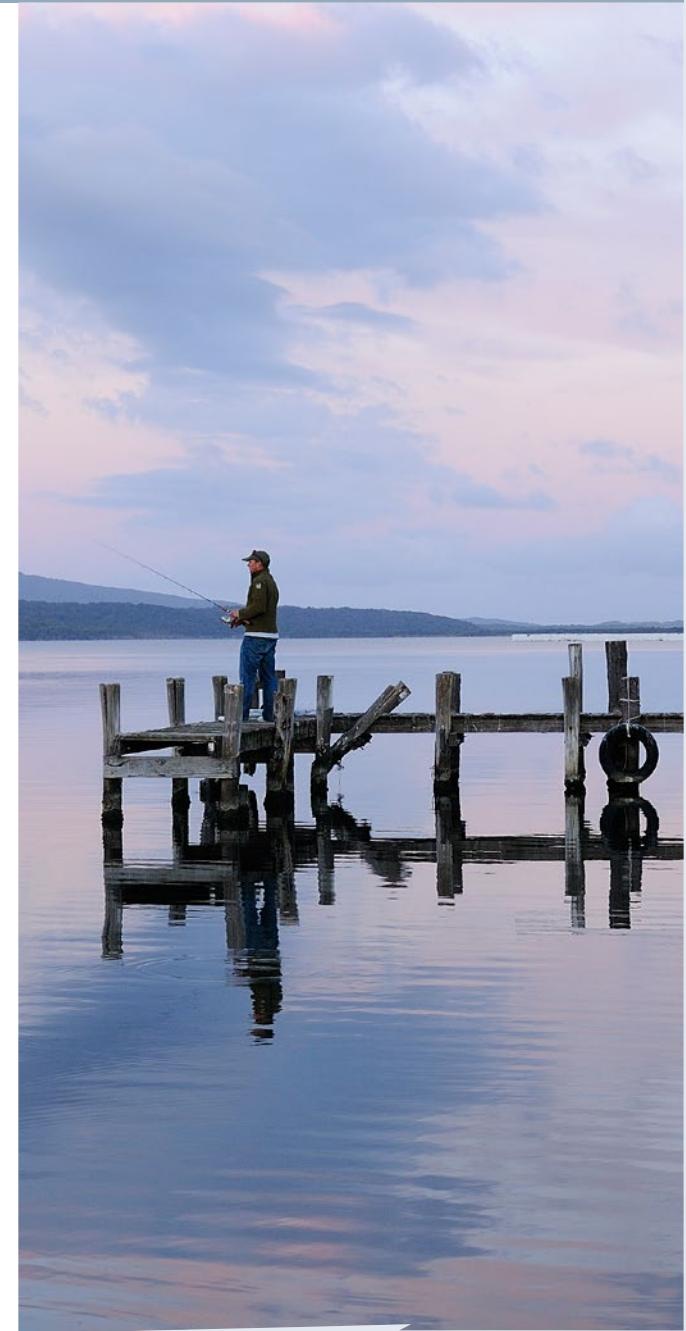
