what is the project?

The Traralgon Activity Centre Plan will comprise both a Structure Plan, intended to guide land use, and an Urban Design Framework, intended to guide built form and landscape character. The work is



being undertaken by hansen partnership, a leading urban design and planning consultancy, who are working closely with both Council and experts in the areas of economics, transport and community.





visioning – seeing traralgons future

session details

second round of consultation: innovation and ideas

This phase is all about thinking outside the box to address the issues raised by both experts and the Traralgon community during the previous 'information download' sessions. This will be structured as a series of interactive themed sessions on the first day. Consultants will facilitate discussion around the issues raised during the first stage and put pen to paper to draw up potential solutions. The consultants will then pull together all the ideas from those sessions and present them to the community on the next afternoon. This will give everyone an opportunity to look at the different concepts generated, read the principles that will guide the structure plan and provide feedback.
