LATROBE CITY PROFILE

Latrobe City is a vibrant regional City with a population of 75,000 and is recognised as one of the four major Victorian regional cities and one of the fastest growing non-metropolitan centres in Australia. The City is made up of four major urban centres: Churchill, Moe/Newborough, Morwell and Traralgon, with seven smaller townships of Boolarra, Glengarry, Toongabbie, Tyers, Traralgon South, Yallourn North, and Yinnar.

Only 90 minutes away from Melbourne, Latrobe City boasts all the recreational and cultural facilities of a large diverse regional centre including the Latrobe City Sports and Entertainment Stadium, Latrobe Regional Gallery and Latrobe Performing Arts Centre with the added benefit of being nestled amongst some of the best tourist attractions in the state, such as the Morwell National Park, Hazelwood Pondage, Lake Narracan, Victory Park and Tarra Bulga National Park.

The beautiful and highly productive Latrobe Valley is located at the gateway to Gippsland in the South East corner of the state of Victoria. Latrobe City is diverse, substantial and really is a new energy in regional Australia.

LATROBE LEISURE CHURCHILL

Latrobe Leisure Churchill has recently undergone a \$4 million redevelopment which has transformed the facility into a world class recreational centre comprising fitness, swimming and stadium services.

The facility is fast becoming known as a host to elite sport including FIBA Oceania Basketball, National Women's Volleyball training camp and State League Netball.

This centre has been utilised by elite sporting clubs such as the AFL, Super Rugby and A-Leauge for training and recovery sessions.

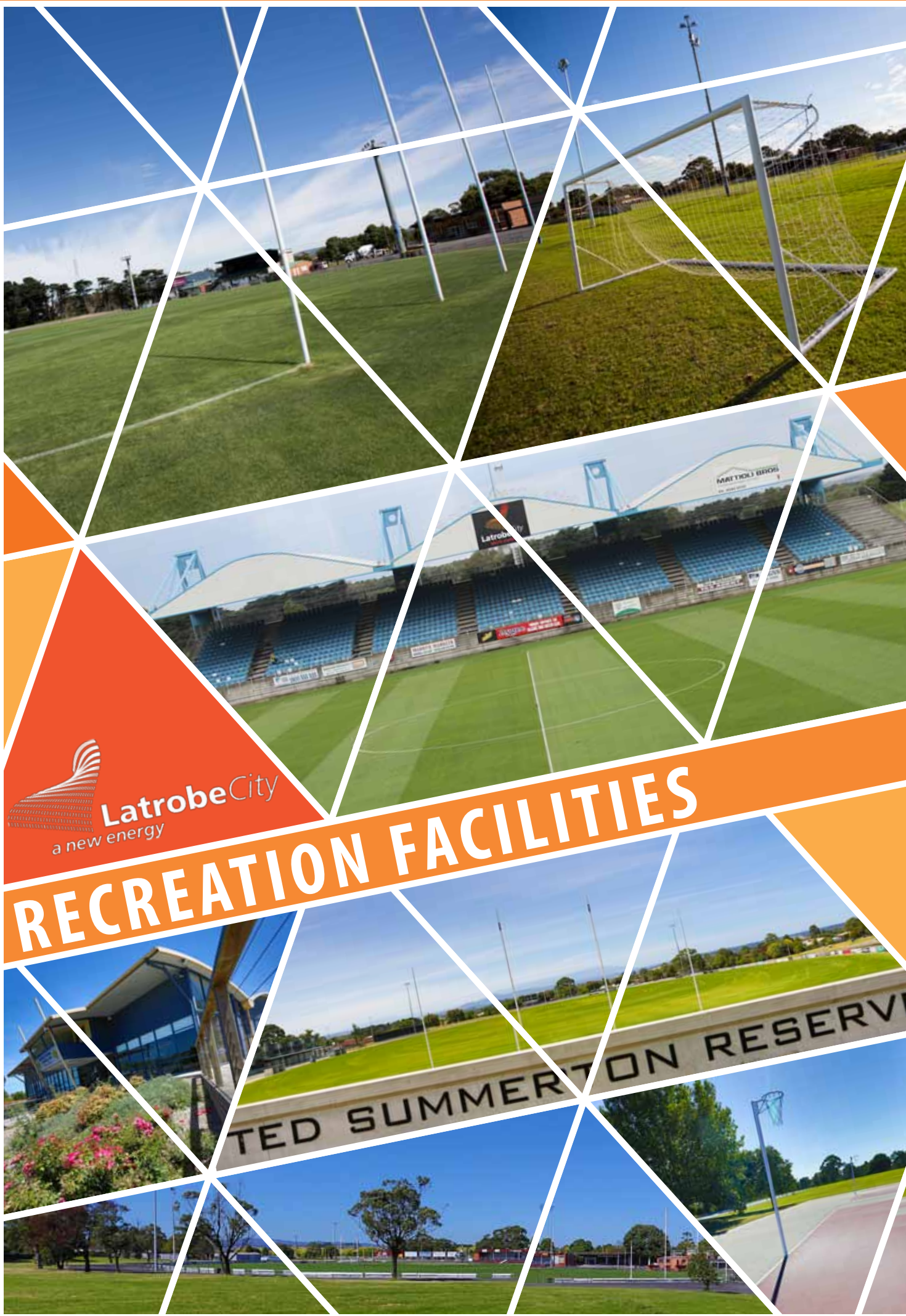
The facility is extensively used by various basketball associations, badminton and netball and has been used for Commonwealth games basketball and pre season NBL matches.

RECREATION FACILITIES

ATED SUMMERTON RESERV

LATROBE CITY SPORTS AND ENTERTAINMENT STADIUM

Built in 1981, this facility was home to the Gippsland Falcons during their tenure in the defunct National Soccer League now known as the A-League. In recent years the facility is fast becoming known as a host to major events such as the A-League regional and preseason fixtures, W-League regional fixtures, Football Federation Victoria championships and EPL football coaching ventures.

- **Three (3) additional reserve grass playing fields**

- **Four 900 lux lighting** on each playing fields
- **Permanent change room facilities** including family and special needs change rooms
- **Multiple canteen facilities throughout venue**
- **Club room facilities** overlooking main grass playing field with full catering available

MORWELL RECREATION RESERVE

Morwell Recreation Reserve has recently undergone a redevelopment which has transformed the facility into a world class recreational reserve. With the redevelopment, the venue now boast a state of the art indoor training facility and Category A grass playing surface.

Morwell Recreation Reserve is also a host to a number of regional elite sporting associations including AFL Gippsland, Netball Victoria and Gippsland Power. The facility is fast becoming known as a host to elite sports including Pre Season AFL fixtures and Cricket Victoria events.

TED SUMMERTON RESERVE, MOE

The Ted Summerton Reserve has recently undergone significant redevelopment which has transformed the facility into a vibrant educational and recreational community precinct.

The new pavilion contains change facilities, umpire change facilities, a multipurpose room, home coaching boxes, a commercial kitchen, toilets, a gym, laundry, and full disability access.

The refurbished reserve includes tiered parking and seating for optimal viewing, traffic management and upgraded lighting to the reserve.

In October 2013 the Traralgon Recreation Reserve main oval underwent a surface refurbishment to upgrade the surface to ensure it provided strength and stability all year round.

The facility is fast becoming known as a major events destination with high profiled national and state events being held here.

TRARALGON TENNIS CLUB

In 2012, the Traralgon Tennis Complex underwent a redevelopment which has transformed the facility into a world class tennis complex. Traralgon has been hosting international events for over two decades and it is now known for the clubs ability to host world class tennis events.

The Traralgon Tennis Complex has hosted a number of international events including 23 years of ITF Junior Championships, Australian Pro Tour Tournaments and recently attracted the APT Men's Challenger. All three events always attract a strong field of players including Roger Federer, Rafael Nadal, Casey Dellacqua, Alicia Molik and many more.

In March 2014 the Traralgon Bowls Club hosted the Trans Tasman Test Series where the world's top 2 bowls nations, the Australian Jackaroos and New Zealand Black Jacks battled it out in a 3 day clash.

Consisting of 10 recently resurfaced netball courts, a multi-purpose sporting pavilion, one public toilet, two car parks, connecting perimeter pathway and a large open grassed area, Agnes Brereton Reserve provides opportunity for both formal and informal recreation pursuits.

HAZELWOOD PONDAGE

Lake Hazelwood also known as Hazelwood Pondage is a man-made lake which was created as a cooling pond for the Hazelwood Power Station. This form of use keeps the water quite temperate all year round. Due to this the lake has become a popular destination for swimming and boating. On the shores of the lake there is park land, a pony club, caravan parks, boat launching areas and camp sites.

LAKE NARRACAN

Lake Narracan is an artificial lake on the Latrobe River built to supply cooling water for the nearby brown coal-fired power stations.

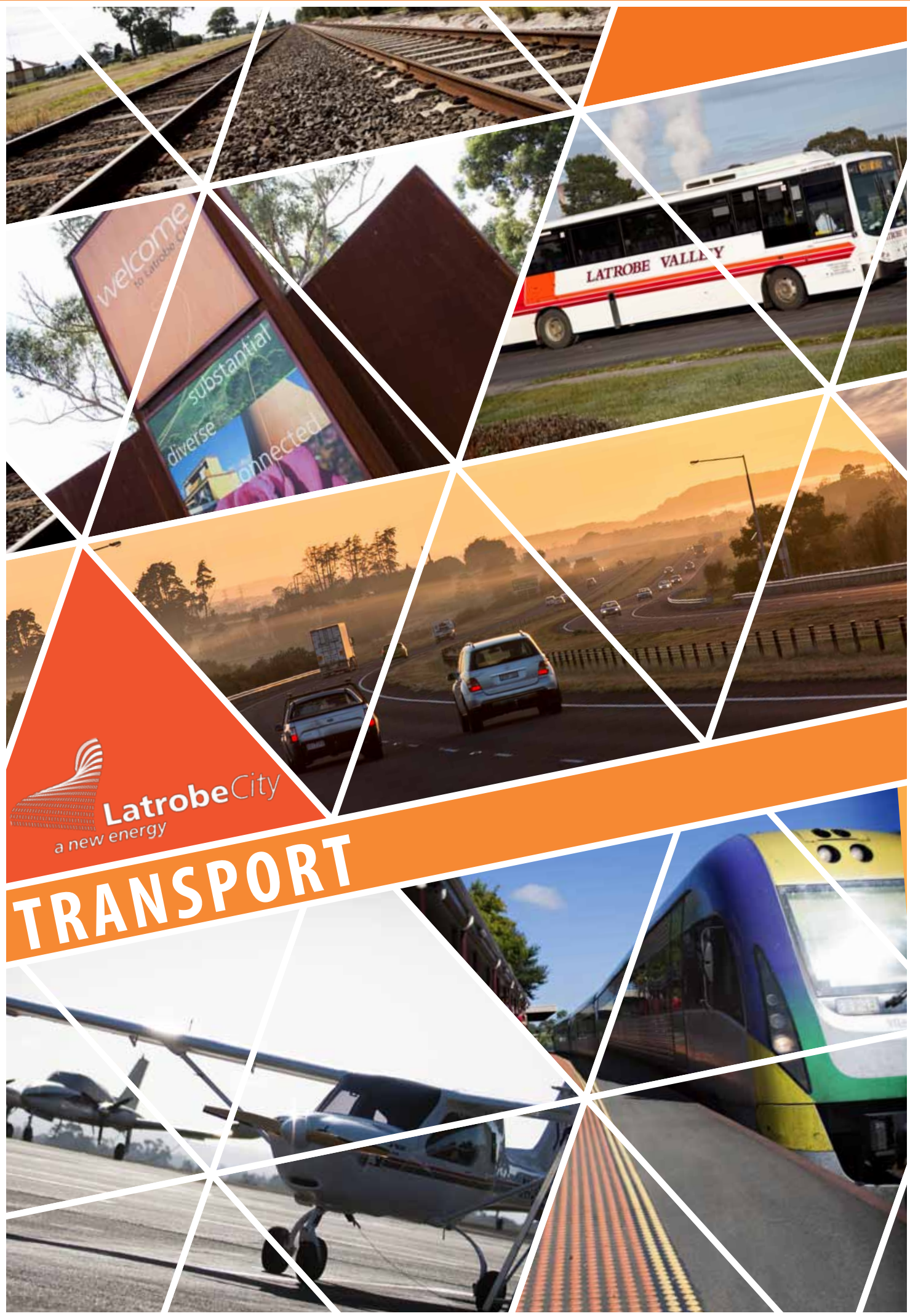
Lake Narracan is also used for recreational purposes, including waterskiing, jet skiing, swimming, recreational fishing, and bush walking on the shore. On the southern shore there is a caravan park and campground.

A number of user groups utilise Lake Narracan including the Latrobe Valley Model Aero Club and the Latrobe Valley Water Ski Club. The Latrobe Valley Water Ski Club hosts a number international, national, state and club events each year. The course is an internationally recognised course.

TOURISM IN LATROBE CITY

WALHALLA HISTORICAL TOWNSHIP

Nestled deep in a pretty valley of Victoria's Mountain Rivers region is Walhalla Historic Township, once a bustling gold mining town. Tours of the 'Long Mine Extended Mine' provide an appreciation of times past and authentic buildings, artefacts and cemetery tell of how life was. The spectacular local scenery can be fully appreciated while riding the 'Goldfields Railway' as it winds its way over the Thomson River.



TARRA BULGA NATIONAL PARK

The park is located in south-eastern Victoria's Strzelecki Ranges, one of only four major areas of cool temperature rainforest in the state. Tarra Bulga is a popular picnic spot with facilities provided at the Bulga picnic area, Tarra Valley picnic area and at the Visitors Centre.

The rainforest is full of song birds so keep an eye out for the unique Lyrebird, Pilot bird, Crimson Rosella and Yellow Robin. Yellow tailed black Cockatoos may fly over with their creaking calls, but don't be fooled – the Lyrebird is a clever mimic. Quite walkers might see the shy Lyrebird scratching the forest floor in search of food. There is a bush walk to suit everyone.

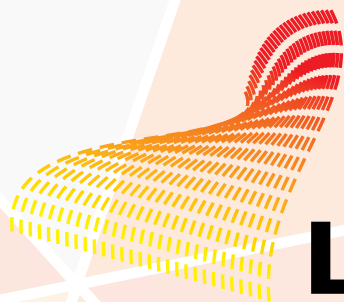
